



# **Recommended Installation by a Professional Plumbing Contractor**

### Important Notes (please read before installing)

- Recommended water pressure: 45 to 80 psi
- Product is designed to allow for installation in accordance with all national and local plumbing and building codes.
- During floor mounting of this product, extra care should be taken while drilling into the floor to avoid damaging any water supply lines that may exist beneath the floor.
- **<u>NOTE</u>**: Use plumbers tape or equivalent to seal all threaded joints.
- **WARNING:** To prevent severe damage to valve body, any solder/braze process must be performed a min. of 4" from ports.

# Installation Instruction for Wood Joist Support Floor




Figure 2: Wood Joist Support Floor Installation

- 1. Use a 2" X 8" wood beam to construct a CROSS SUPPORT BRACE as shown in **Figure 2**. Position the CROSS SUPPORT BRACE so its top surface is approximately 4-1/4" from the FINISHED FLOOR. Check the horizontal level by placing a level across the top surface of the CROSS SUPPORT BRACE.
- 2. Orient the Inlet Fittings of the Rough-In to the water supply source. Use the provided WOOD SCREWS (8X) to attach the Rough-In to the CROSS SUPPORT BRASS.
- 3. Remove PLUGS from inlets of the Rough-In. Utilize appropriate supply line and  $\frac{1}{2}$ " male thread adapter to connect supply line to the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " NPT inlets of the Rough.
- 4. Turn on water supply and check for leaks.
- 5. Installation for the Rough-In Kit is now completed. To install Exposed Tub Sets and Floor Mount Kit, follow installation instructions provided with the Floor Mount Kit 3-196.

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# Installation Instruction for Concrete Floor




Figure 3: Concrete Floor Installation

- 1. As shown in **Figure 3**, position the rough so that the top surface of PLATE is approximately 3-3/4" from the FINISHED FLOOR
- 2. Check the horizontal level of the rough by placing a level across the PLATE. Orient the Inlet Fittings of the Rough to the water supply source.
- 3. Remove PLUGS from Inlets of the Rough. Utilize appropriate supply line and  $\frac{1}{2}$ " male thread adapters to connect supply line to the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " NPT inlets of the Rough.
- 4. Turn on water supply and check for leaks.
- 5. Pour concrete and complete the FINISHED FLOOR. Note: Use MUDGUARD to prevent floor material from covering the OUTLET of Rough.
- 6. Installation for the Rough-In Kit is now completed. To install Exposed Tub Sets and Floor Mount Kit, follow installation instructions provided with the Floor Mount Kit 3-196.

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# LIMITED WARRANTY

Brasstech, Inc. warrants to the original consumer residential purchaser ("Original Purchaser") that if a product in its; Newport Brass®, Brasstech®, motiv®, Newport 365 or GINGER®lines of products ("Product") is confirmed upon inspection to be defective in materials or workmanship during the warranty periods described below, Brasstech, Inc. will, at its option, either repair or replace the Product with a similar current model of the Product. If repair or replacement is not commercially practical or cannot be made in a timely manner, then Brasstech, Inc. will provide a refund for the Product.

#### WARRANTY PERIODS AND COVERAGE PRODUCT FINISHES

• PVD and Polished Chrome (26) finishes on Products other than Drains and Shower rods are warranted as long as the Original Purchaser owns their home.

•"Living" finishes have no warranty\*.These include 03N & 08W.

• Shower rods, porcelain parts and glass parts have no finish warranty.

• Mirror products will be warranted from desilvering for two (2) years from the date of purchase by the original purchaser as long as desilvering is not due to chemical contact. See maintenance section for proper cleaning instructions.

• All other finishes are warranted for ten (10) years from date of purchase by the Original Purchaser.

#### **DRAIN FINISHES**

• Polished Chrome (26) and PVD finishes on kitchen, bath or lavatory drains including drain baskets and components are warranted for one (1) year from date of purchase by the Original Purchaser.

• All other Drain finishes have no warranty.

#### FUNCTIONALITY

• All Product parts except valves are warranted for ten (10) years from date of purchase by the Original Purchaser.

• Ceramic disc valves for the lavatory faucet, tub/ shower and roman tub are warranted for as long as the Original Purchaser owns the home.

• All other valves (balance pressure, thermostatic, etc.) are warranted for one (1) year from date of purchase by the Original Purchaser.

Lights have no functional warranty. Soap / Lotion pump mechanisms are warranted for one (1) year from date of purchase by the Original Purchaser.
Shower rods, porcelain parts and glass parts have no functional warranty.
Hot water tanks are warranted for one (1) year from the date of purchase by the original purchaser.

#### **EXCLUSIONS FROM COVERAGE**

• This Warranty does not cover labor charges or associated costs for, or damages occurring during the removal, transportation, return or installation of Products or replacement Products.

• This Warranty does not cover damage or defects due to normal wear and tear, misuse, abuse, hard water, improper storage, improper handling, improper maintenance\*\*, improper installation\*\*\* or uses other than normal household usage\*\*\*\*.

• This warranty is non-transferable.

• Products sold to customers for use as display items are not meant for resale and are not covered under any functional or finish warranty.

#### PRODUCT CARE

Simple care is all that is needed in maintaining this product. Abrasive cleansers, detergents and silver or brass polish may result in damage to the finish and therefore should not be used. To clean, simply wipe with a soft, water dampened cloth. GINGER® hand, deck and wall shower sprays feature easy-cleaning jets. The jets should be cleaned periodically by rubbing your thumb or a damp cloth across the jets to loosen mineral deposits. Run the shower spray briefly to purge the loosened deposits.

#### **\* UNCOATED AND LIVING FINISHES**

Uncoated and Living finishes such as Polished Brass Uncoated (03N) and living finishes such as Weathered Copper (08W), do naturally weather and change color over time. Living and uncoated finishes are not warranted.

#### **\*\* MAINTENANCE**

Proper maintenance is required to preserve all finishes. Do not use any abrasive cleaners, alcohol, ammonia, detergents, or brass or silver polish on the Products. For complete care requirements and recommendations, please visit our website at www.brasstech.com.

#### **\*\*\* PROPER INSTALLATION**

Products must be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions supplied with the Products.
